



IMPORTANT UPDATE: NEW AUTOMATED WASTE SERVICES

Starting August 29, 2022, Scott Waste Services, LLC will begin delivering new carts to the residents of Bowling Green currently using personal waste cans.

Here's what this means for you:

Garbage will be collected once a week, and cans must be placed curbside the night before your scheduled pickup.

Place all garbage in the cart provided. See back of this flyer for placement instructions.

Beginning September 12, we will be able to service more stops more efficiently using our automated trucks. Please be sure to use the provided cans by that time.

BULKY COLLECTION

We will also be providing weekly pickup of one bulky and oversized item per week.

This means you will need to make sure the bulky item you wish to dispose of is placed curbside, along with your cans, the night before your scheduled pickup.

YARD WASTE

To dispose of yard waste, please ensure that the items are placed in biodegradable bags, OR tied together in a bundle. Please ensure the bundle is no longer than 4 feet, and weighs no more than 50 pounds before placing curbside.

A few placement tips to follow...

to ensure the collection of your garbage, recyclables or yard waste



There should be 3 feet between carts, yard waste bags and structures such as mail boxes, cars and lamp posts

should be within 18 inches of the curb


Face the short metal bar toward the street

Position the cart on as level a surface possible, away from overhanging tree branches

Make sure lid is closed

Place your bin carefully & leave space on all sides!
