

Also garbage: Styrofoam[™], bubble wrap envelopes, food-soiled paper, wires, hoses, clothing, compostable plastics, pet waste, diapers and lumber. Some items can be recycled at **drop-off locations**.

In your **Recycling Container**

Plastic bottles, jugs and round containers

6 ounces or larger, no lids



Paper, cardboard, cartons, etc.





Empty and rinse all containers. Flatten cardboard. When in doubt, throw it in the garbage.


In your **Yard Debris Cart**Available in urban areas

Leaves, flowers, grass, weeds, tree and shrub trimmings

Less than four inches in diameter and 36 inches in length.

No lumber.

* Lake Oswego, Milwaukie, and Wilsonville residents may include food scraps.



On the Side

MOTOR OIL

Put **used motor oil** in a marked, capped, screw-top container and set next to glass bin. Residential only.
