RIDGE LANDFILL LIAISON COMMITTEE TUESDAY, JUNE 8, 2021 SCHEDULED SECOND QUARTER MEETING

The Ridge Landfill Liaison Committee held its regular meeting on the above date commencing at 10:03 a.m. onsite at the John League Building Meeting Room at Talbot Trail Place Park.

1. MINUTES:

JOHN VERMEY - CATHY SMITH:

2. **BUSINESS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES:**

(a) Odour Complaint Follow-up

Marc Leduc reports that the landfill has received two odour complaints recently from one complainant and the Facility followed its protocols to bury the offending waste as quickly as possible. Marc also relates that the three landfill gas flares continue to operate as well as the odour-suppression misters. Recent repairs to the landfill gas collection headers also reduce odours. General Committee discussions indicate that odour intensity is dependent on the prevailing weather with stronger odours associated with higher humidity and landfilling at greater elevations.

Marc also reported one noise complaint recently from a neighbour to the northeast related to back-up alarms. Onsite equipment is progressively being retrofitted with low-frequency alarms to reduce the distance that the sound travels but select trucks that unload at the Ridge Landfill continue to use the typical high-frequency alarms.

(b) <u>Update on Ridge Landfill Expansion</u>

Cathy Smith reported that the Environmental Assessment (EA) Approval for the landfill expansion was received on October 29, 2020 and post-approval requirements are ongoing and provided for MECP review upon completion, including the Indigenous Consultation Plan which was provided for review and approval approximately two weeks ago. Cathy also reported that the waste cell for the expanded site started receiving waste construction in April 2021. The updated Landfill Community Trust agreement is currently in progress.

Rick will coordinate with Ridge Landfill representatives before the next meeting in September to investigate if arrangements can be made for visitors. General Committee discussions identify concerns regarding social distancing since vehicles are required to tour the landfill.
