

## Fundraising for Malibu Club YL Camp, July 2-8, 2024

This information is designed to help communicate the opportunities students have to raise funds for Newberg YL going to Young Life's Malibu Club Camp this summer! Below, you will find a description of our fundraisers and scholarship opportunities. The amount made on fundraisers is incredibly flexible based on the effort your student puts into it. We have seen many students over the years earn most, if not all, of their camp cost. We have at least one significant opportunity for your student to fundraise each month until the deadline to sign up for camp arrives (early Spring).

### **Cinnamon Rolls Sales: Nov. 20th- Dec. 1st, 2023, Pick-up on Dec. 9, 10-Noon.**

Students will pre-sell dozens of cinnamon rolls for \$25 per pan and earn \$15 per dozen. The rolls can be cooked right away or frozen- perfect for Christmas morning!

### **Coffee Sales: January 1-15, 2024, Delivery on January 22, 2024**

We work with Caravan Coffee Roasters in Newberg to sell coffee for camp. The bags are 12oz and are sold for \$20, students receive \$10 per bag.

### **Pickleball Tournament: February 11, 2024**

We are in the process of securing a location to hold an indoor pickleball tournament. Students can sell entry fees to players (\$30 for one event, \$50 for two events) and get sponsored to play in the tournament. 100% of sponsorships and 75% of the fees collected for player entry fees will go towards their camp cost.

### **Paint Night on March 8, 2024**

Students will sell tickets to the paint night. Cost of tickets will be \$45 and students will receive \$35 per ticket they sell if they volunteer at the event and \$25 if they do not.

### **Hanging Basket Flower Sales: April 1-30, 2024, Pick-up May 10, 2024, 9-11am**

This fundraiser is designed for students to presell Mother's Day flower baskets for camp money. We will order baskets from a local nursery that will be delivered the Friday before Mother's Day (May 10). The basket price will be known in January. Students will receive approximately \$14 per basket towards camp.

### **Bark Dust/ Mulch Fundraiser: April 6th & 20th, 2024**

This event is designed for students to show up and WORK! Young Life staff will do all of the organization of this fundraiser; all the student has to do is show up to work on their assigned bark spreading crew. Pay will be determined by the number of hours a student works (usually around \$20/hr.). Students will need to show up in work clothes with: gloves, water and food. We can always use help from parents which earns double (or triple) the money towards camp.

### **Other ideas:**

Of course you can do fundraising on your own! We strongly encourage you to do this as well as participate in any or all of the above listed fundraisers. Some other things that have worked really well in the past are: write a letter to friends and family explaining the opportunity to go to camp and the need for help from them to make it possible, a garage sale (we do have lots of stuff to put in it if a parent wants to organize it!), collecting cans to recycle, car wash (if a parent wants to organize this it has great potential), babysitting, yard work at a neighbor or family's home, bake sale, etc. etc.! The possibilities and amount that can be earned really is up to you!

### **Area Scholarships:**

We work very hard to help fundraise for camp, and we are able to offer scholarships. We want to make sure that our scholarship offers are clearly communicated. We will match a student's fundraising efforts, **up to \$150**; this is the maximum amount we can offer each student towards their camp. In other words, you need to work to fundraise at any of the opportunities listed above, and then we will match you! This match is only for Young Life organized fundraisers and you must apply to be considered (applications will be sent in June).

I hope that this letter and these events help to dispel any anxiety there may be about the cost of our summer camp. These students will be going on an international trip and get to spend 7 days at an all-inclusive resort. We firmly believe this week will be the best week of each student's life!
