The City of Ely's 4th of July Parade will be on Monday, July 4th at 1 p.m. Line up starts at 10 a.m. on 4th Ave from Harvey Street to Boundary Street including the Ice Arena Parking lot and the green space. If you are participating in the parade please enter the lineup area at 4th Ave and Boundary Street we will have parade workers to direct you to your line up spot.

Please call City Hall, Clerk's Office at 218-365-3224 ext. 1 to sign up to be in the parade. We will have judging on the following categories, Commercial, Non Commercial, and Most Patriotic. Judging will be from 11am-Noon.

There will be ribbons & prizes awarded for kids entering the parade with decorated bikes, trikes, wagons, costumes, etc. Judging will be from 11:30 - Noon.

Parade starts at 4th Ave and Harvey St and follows Harvey Street to 2nd Ave East and then down Sheridan St, ending at 8th Ave (Whiteside Park).
