

Summer Camp Medication & Health Form Requirements

Health Forms

Young Life requires that all camp participants (every person on camp) provide a completed health form <u>upon arrival</u>. For any non-online forms: The health form MUST be signed on each signature line.

Vaccination Requirements

New York State requires that all campers (and staff) provide record of immunizations that includes the dates for each dose. The best practice is to upload the complete immunization record for yourself or Child attending camp.

Campers must have their record uploaded onto their online health form before arrival or have a paper copy turned in upon arrival.

Medication Information

- Before Camp: All campers who will be taking prescription or non-prescription medication while
 attending camp must complete a medication rider form in addition to the standard Young Life
 health and consent form(s).
 - The medication rider form must be completed by the prescribing physician to authorize camp medical staff to administer and assist with self-administration of prescription and non-prescription medications.
- At the Bus (during check in): Collect Medications and Medical Riders in zip lock bags clearly labeled with the camper's name and area number.
 - Medications must be in their original prescription bottles/packaging
- At the welcome tent: Turn in all camper medications, medical riders, paper health forms, and paper immunization forms to the Head Leader/Camp Staff
 - Emergency medications (EPI pens, Albuterol Inhalers) will not be collected.
- **During Camp:** All medications will be held in the camp infirmary, and medical staff will ensure that each camper takes their prescribed medication as scheduled.
